### Water Related Matters

### Water Testing

We will be testing for E. coli readings twice this season as per usual at 30 predetermined sites around the lake. The spring sampling will be done the week of June 4<sup>th</sup> while the end of season sampling will be done the week of August 13<sup>th</sup>. E. coli is measured to gauge the cleanliness of the water for swimming purposes.

Again this summer, the Association will participate in a Provincial water testing program that aims to benchmark water quality and clarity across as many lakes in Quebec as possible. Samples will be collected in June, July and August and remitted to the province for testing with a focus on chlorophyll, phosphate and dissolved organic carbon levels which are the key drivers of water clarity and algae growth.

### Safety buoys

Depending on water levels, between 21 and 24 buoys are installed in mid-May and will be in place until the Thanksgiving long weekend. Please keep away from the buoys when boating as large wakes can displace the buoys.



### Water levels

The water level is measured bi-weekly (thanks to the efforts of Kevin Scott and Chantal Vaillancourt). These readings will be reported as usual in our fall newsletter.

The Association periodically receives emails related to water level fluctuations. There are many factors that affect the lake water level including spring run-off, rain volume, summer temperatures and beaver/human activity vis a vis dams. The lake association has no mandate or ability to impact lake water levels. Should you have questions or concerns related to this issue, please contact the appropriate representative listed below.

### **Boat washing**

The boat washing station is available for free the entire boating season in the parking lot at the Community Centre in East Aldfield across the street from the Ptit magasin général. **This is a brand-new pressure washer so we ask that you handle it with care**.

It is very important that all boats, trailers and other vessels that have been exposed to other bodies of water (other than Lake Sinclair) are thoroughly washed prior to being put into our lake. Foreign invasive species are very prevalent in surrounding lakes and rivers and are easily transported to other bodies of water causing irreparable harm in many cases. There is no charge for using the boat wash and it only takes a few minutes to do. Be sure to pass this info on to your guests who may bring a boat or other water vessel with them when visiting.



### **Internet Access Update**

### As of May 2023

As most of us have heard, the Quebec government undertook an ambitious project to ensure all homes in the province are supplied with high-speed internet. According to *The Low-Down*, this was a \$1.3 Billion dollar project funded by the province and the federal government. The various projects were apparently split up between Bell and Cogeco. The original completion date was to be September 2022 but that was pushed back to December, then March 2023 and then July 2023.

Around the lake there are apparently a number of current suppliers including Xplornet, Digicom, Starlink, Cogeco and Bell.

Cogeco and contractor trucks have been seen along the west and north sides of the lake on Lac Sinclair Road Rd and fiber optic cable has been installed (wrapped to the Bell line) along some power lines in the area.



Inquiries made by the Association to La Pêche, Low Township and the MNA's office responsible for this project have not resulted in any detailed updates. It appears that our municipal offices have not been receiving any direct updates from the province. We are instead all generally advised to use the province's interactive map. You can find this at :

In this interactive map you will find a window to type in an address. Once you do that you should be given a projected service completion date and supplier.

A recent inquiry for an address on Ch de la Péninsule on Baie Simon, Low Township, resulted in a response that service is currently supplied by Starlink and will be available from Digicom by July 31st, 2023.


This may reflect a rumor that Digicom is taking over Cogeco, or at least some of the high-speed internet projects around our lake. Information on whether and when Cogeco service might be available in your area may also be found at <u>cogeco.ca</u> and clicking on "Can I get Cogeco at home?"

### **Stray Dogs Rules and Regulations**

As the animal control inspector for La Peche, I have seen an increase in dog infractions in the area of lac Sinclair . Anitek would like to address this problem by informing the residents as to the consequences of the by-law. Anitek would prefer that you enjoy the company of your dog in a safe and responsible manner.

Please take time to insure that you can provide a safe environment for your dog, pedestrians and their dogs.

Summer is a time of pleasure for both residents and their dogs. The following information will inform you on the risks of your dog being loose and other related situations.

When you are a non resident of La Pêche your dog must wear a valid license from

your city. If you do not , you must get a license from La Pêche when you are staying for more than 15 days.

When your dog is loose it is in danger of porcupines, skunks and coyotes. Porcupine quills must be extracted by a veterinarian. The cost is significantly high when you have to go to the emergency hospital in Ottawa . So think twice before you let your dog loose or do not take any precautions to keep them on your Property.

Fines

- 1st infraction \$654.00
- 2nd infraction \$1154.00

You must ensure that your dog cannot intimidate people who are walking on the roads. This offense can lead to your dog being declared potentially dangerous and can be liable under the dangerous dog by-law.


\* Dangerous dog \* ( 8.5 - 8.11 ) (8.39-8.42)

These are the consequences if your dog is declared dangerous by the municipality,

- 1. Dog must submit to an evaluation by a specialized veterinarian in aggressive dog
- 2. behaviour. (Cost of \$800.00)
- 3. Owner of dog will receive a court ordered ordinance that will restrict normal
- 4. activities with your dog for the rest of his life.
- 5. Minimum fine of \$1000.00 for being declared dangerous.
- 6. Maximum fine of \$2500.00 for every infraction to the ordinance.
- 7. Possible judgement of euthanasia.


